# School Uniform

Please see our School Uniform Policy on the school website, for what is appropriate for the children to wear to school. Although comfortable in the warmer weather, open-toe sandals are not safe for the children to wear to school. Exposed toes are prone to injury and, therefore, the children must wear closed-toe shoes to school. Thank you. Another polite reminder to make sure that all school uniform is named, or labelled. The children frequently remove their jumpers, or cardigans during the warmer weather, and this makes it very hard to return clothing to their rightful owner if they are not named. We know how expensive uniform items are and we do not want you to have to replace them unnecessarily.



# Class Photographs

Each class will have their photograph taken on **Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> June.** Auckland (FS2) and Nelson (Year 6) will have a special 'vista' photograph to mark their first and last year at the school. The children will need to wear their **full school uniform** on this day, even if they have PE. Please may Auckland and Nelson Class all bring a special prop in on this day that shows a subject, or activity, that they particularly enjoy; please ask your child's class teacher for ideas about what they can bring in.

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# End of Year Awards Assemblies

At the end of the school year we hold an end of year celebration assembly for KS1 and KS2 and invite family members to join us for these special occasions. During the assemblies, **all of the children** are presented with a personal certificate, celebrating their achievements, hard work and talents. Auckland, Brisbane and Canberras' assembly will take place on **Monday 17<sup>th</sup> July at 9.15am** and Darwin, Elliston, Geraldton and Nelsons' will take place on **Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> July at 9.15am**. We look forward to you joining us for these special events.

## Relationships, Sex and Health Education

During Term 6 and as part of our safeguarding curriculum, all of the children will take part in age-appropriate Relationships, Sex and Health Education (RSE) lessons. This aspect of the curriculum is covered through our science and PSHE curriculum and became compulsory for all schools from September 2020. At primary school, the main focus is on celebrating differences and promoting respectful relationships. The older children in school will learn about the changes that occur during puberty. As a school, we will share our programme of study and RSE Policy with you prior to teaching this area of the curriculum.

# Year 6 Leavers' Services

There will be two services for our Year 6 leavers. The first will take place at Salisbury Cathedral, with other schools in the Diocese, on **Wednesday the 5<sup>th</sup> July**. This service is just for the children and school staff.

The second takes place at school on **Thursday 20**<sup>th</sup> **July, at 1.30pm,** in the church. During this school service, we will be celebrating each child and wishing them a fond farewell as they leave for secondary school. Further details will be sent out about the service nearer the time.

## School Swimming Lessons



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Nelson and Canberra Class will benefit from swimming this term. A separate letter, with further information, has been sent out via eSchools and a payment item has been set up on Parent Pay for voluntary contributions towards the cost of the swimming lessons.

# Statutory Assessments

The Department for Education have reinstated all statutory assessments for primary schools for this academic year. The following statutory assessments have already taken place last Term:

KS1 SATs Tests

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KS2 SATs Tests

The following assessments will take place for the children in the respective year groups this term:

- The Early Years Foundation Stage Profile
- Year 1 Phonics Screening Check
- Year 4 Multiplication Check

Class teachers in every year group will be carrying out assessments this term to feed into the end of year profile of each child. This information, and the results of any statutory assessments, will be reported to you. You will have a chance to discuss these with your child's class teacher during your parent appointment.

# Stop and Think Pilot Project

This year, our school has been part of an educational research project led by the Education Endowment Foundation (EEF). The EEF are a charity and use evidence-based research to improve educational outcomes. As part of this project, Darwin and Geraldton Class will take part in some activities and tasks on **Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> June**, with a representative from the EEF.
