This means that the way attendance concerns are currently dealt with, will change from September 2024. These changes will be communicated with you nearer the time. However, in order to prepare for these change will we be working to support families, if their child's attendance is a concern, this term. Please note that if you are contacted about your child's attendance, the first thing we will do, as a school, is offer our support and work alongside you to see how we can help.
